In order to lessen the possibility of accident, potential operators should undertake forklift training by a certified instructor prior to operating a forklift. All parts of lift truck operation are included in training programs. The restrictions and abilities of the machinery are covered, along with basic operating measures, preoperation inspections and methods of warning other employees that a forklift is in the work area.

Lessons comprise the placement of the chock blocks and trailer tires, the arrangement of pallets to spread out the load properly, and inspections needed before driving into a trailer at a dock site. Courses likewise include Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) training. Although not directly related to the utilization of a lift truck, MSDS training is important if an operator damages a container containing toxic materials, or notices a leaking container. MSDS sheets list the products, their effects on people and proper methods of dealing with spills.
